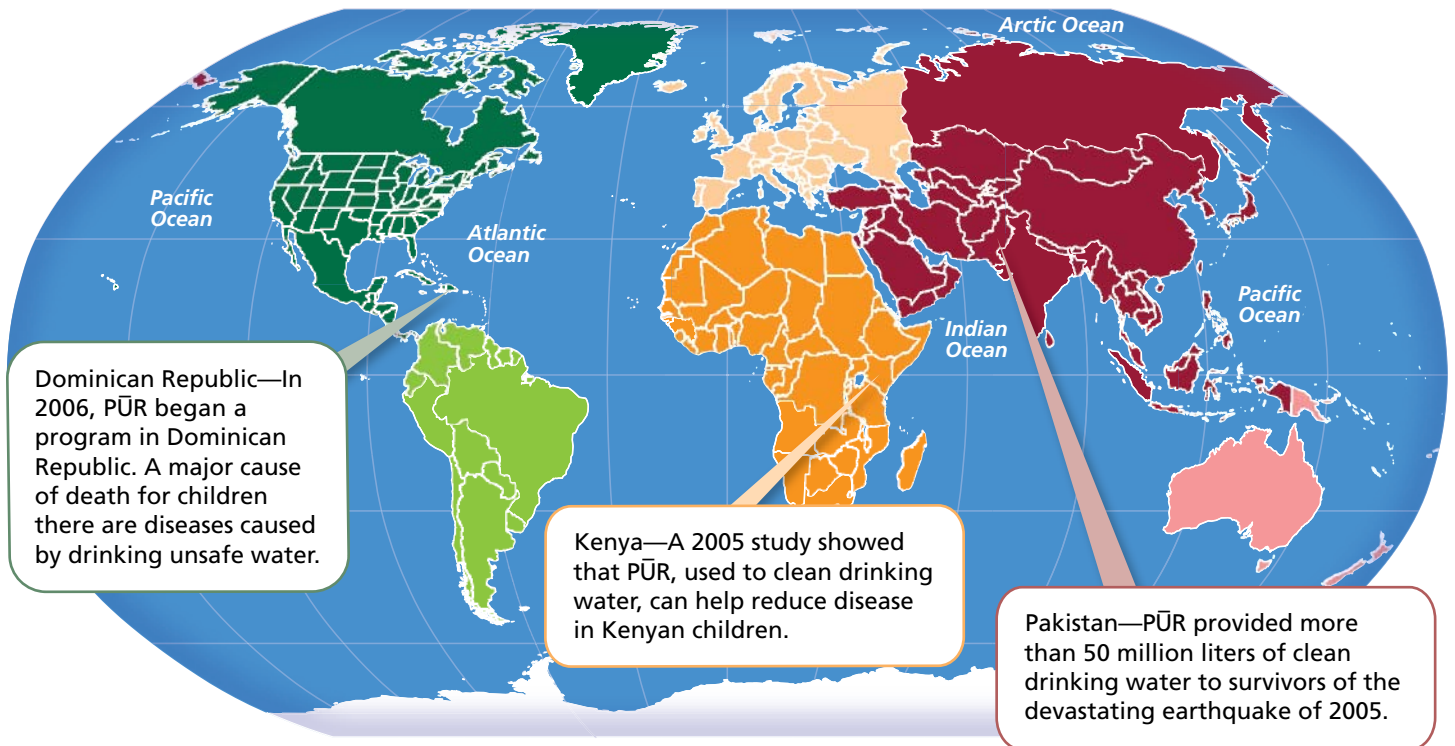

Many people around the world get their water from lakes, rivers, shallow wells, or marshes where the water is muddy or cloudy. The water from these sources may contain contaminants and harmful wastes from animals and humans.

The Children's Safe Drinking Water program helps provide these people with clean drinking water. Volunteers and health professionals teach people about the importance of clean water and how to make dirty water clean with a
